



# SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES & APPLICATION FORM

EQUALS International Institute and the Centre for Equality are pleased to offer the following scholarships:

- 75% tuition fee scholarship for international or domestic students;
- 50% tuition fee scholarship for international or domestic students;
- 25% tuition fee scholarship for international or domestic students;
- Other tuition fee scholarships as may be considered from time to time.

#### **Entry Requirements:**

Please see the basic entry requirements below.

- Minimum age for applicants is 18 years of age (at the time of enrolment)
- If you are an international student, please refer to the International Student Application form for other eligibility criteria (https://equals.edu.au/apply-international-students/)
- Scholarship recipients must be prepared to purchase their own text books and required resources
   the scholarship does not cover these items.

First Nations peoples are encouraged to apply, including Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples.

#### **Scholarship Closing Dates:**

From 2018, scholarship applications will be accepted throughout the year and will be awarded at the sole discretion of the Scholarship Review Panel. Applicants are encouraged to submit their applications at least 90 days prior to the commencement of the scheduled start date.

#### **Scholarship Application Review**

Finalists will be selected for interview. The number of finalists will be at the discretion of the Scholarship Review Panel. Interviews will be conducted by video conference or face to face as appropriate.

The Scholarship Review Panel will review and assess each application on its merits. Consideration will be given to the following:

- Scholarship application
- academic results
- vocational experience (if any)
- resume / CV
- referee statements
- interview

Successful scholarship applicants will be notified in writing by email or post.





#### **Covering Letter**

Your letter of application should not exceed 1000 words, and should include answers to the following questions:

- 1. Why are you applying for this scholarship?
- 2. Please share details of your extra curricular and voluntary activities
- 3. What are your employment goals after graduation?
- 4. What are your primary goals in life and why should we select you for this scholarship?
- 5. What contribution will you bring to the Institute?
- 6. What, if any, special circumstances would you like the Scholarship Review Panel to consider in regard to your scholarship application?

# SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

#### **Scholarship Conditions**

Applicants who meet the scholarship eligibility criteria may apply for one or more of the available scholarships.

Scholarship recipients who have accepted a scholarship are ineligible to apply for any other scholarship rounds. Applicants who are not offered a scholarship are welcome to apply to future scholarship rounds subject to eligibility criteria being met.

EQUALS reserves the right to reduce the value of a scholarship if there are less than the required number of applicants in any given round.

The scholarship covers tuition fees and does not include OSHC, Student Services or Amenities Fees, Accommodation, Text Books or any other costs associated with living and studying in Australia.

Scholarship recipients must comply with all rules, regulations and academic expectations. Failure to do so may result in formal counseling and/or cancellation of the scholarship.

The scholarship is not open to students already studying at the EQUALS International Institute. The scholarship amount will be credited to the final tuition payment.

The awarding of the Scholarship payment depends on the student paying the balance of any student fees by the due date. Students who do not pay the balance of fees by the due date or who do not abide by the agreed payment plan will forfeit the right to their scholarship.

Scholarship recipients are required to complete their studies in the normal or nominal fulltime course duration period. Failure to do so may result in tuition and other charges being applied, and the recipient may forfeit their scholarship benefits.
